

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH

BY-LAW NO. 123

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO CHARGE FIRE EXTINGUISHING COSTS AND FALSE ALARM COSTS TO THE OWNER OF LAND

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, R.S.A., 1980, and amendments thereto provides that a municipality may charge any cost with respect to extinguishing fires to the owner or occupant of land within the municipal boundaries of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach deems it necessary and prudent that some of the cost for fire fighting services be on a full cost recovery basis.


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach, duly assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That all costs with respect to the extinguishing of fire or preserving life or property from injury or destruction by fire on land within the Summer Village of Argentia Beach be charged to the owner of the land on which the fire occurred.
2. That all costs with respect to false alarms be charged to the owner of the land from which the call originated.
3. That all costs are due and payable within 60 days of the date of invoicing to the owner of land on which the fire or false alarm occurred after which time the said costs are deemed to be in default.
4. That, in default of payment, the said cost shall be charged against the owners land as taxes due and owing in respect of that land and be subject to all penalties and costs provided for in By-Law No's. 120 and 121.
5. That this By-law shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
