

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH

BY-LAW NO. 124

A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ARGENTIA BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO RESTRICT CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES FROM ACCESS ON A CERTAIN PART OF THE PUBLIC ROADWAY SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Summer Village of Argentia Beach has the responsibility and obligation to manage the highways, roads, streets and lanes within the boundaries of the Summer Village; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village is authorized to pass by-laws controlling and regulating the use of such highways, as defined in the Highway Traffic Act, being Chapter H-7, R.S.A., 1980 and amendments thereto, in the Summer Village; and

WHEREAS, Clause (p) of Section 16(1) of the said Highway Traffic Act specifically provides authority for a council of a municipality to make by-laws restricting the use of any highway with respect to any class or classes of motor vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Summer Village is of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the Summer Village to place a restriction on certain motor vehicles from travelling on a portion of the Summer Village road.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Argentia Beach, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That all motor vehicles, excepting emergency vehicles described in the said Highway Traffic Act and such other motor vehicles as Council may determine by resolution from time to time, be and are hereby restricted from travelling on that portion of the Summer Village registered roadway that is adjacent to and perpendicular with Lot 17U, Block 3, Plan 3297 NY as shown on Road Plan 2254 E.U. and graphically identified by a red boundary on Appendix "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.

2. That pedestrians, bicycles and other similar types of non-motorized transportation shall be permitted to use the said restricted area identified in Clause 1. above and shown on Appendix "A" attached hereto.

Handwritten signature and initials in the bottom right corner of the page.

3. That a permanent barricade shall be placed at the described location, and motor vehicles approved to use the said restricted road shall be provided with an unlocking tool for the said barricade to ensure through access as and when required.

4. That this By-law shall come into force and effect the latter date of either the final passing thereof or the installation of the aforementioned barricades.

Read a first time this 18th day of May, 1994.

Read a second time this 18th day of May, 1994.

Read a third time with the unanimous consent of Council and finally passed this 18th day of May, 1994.



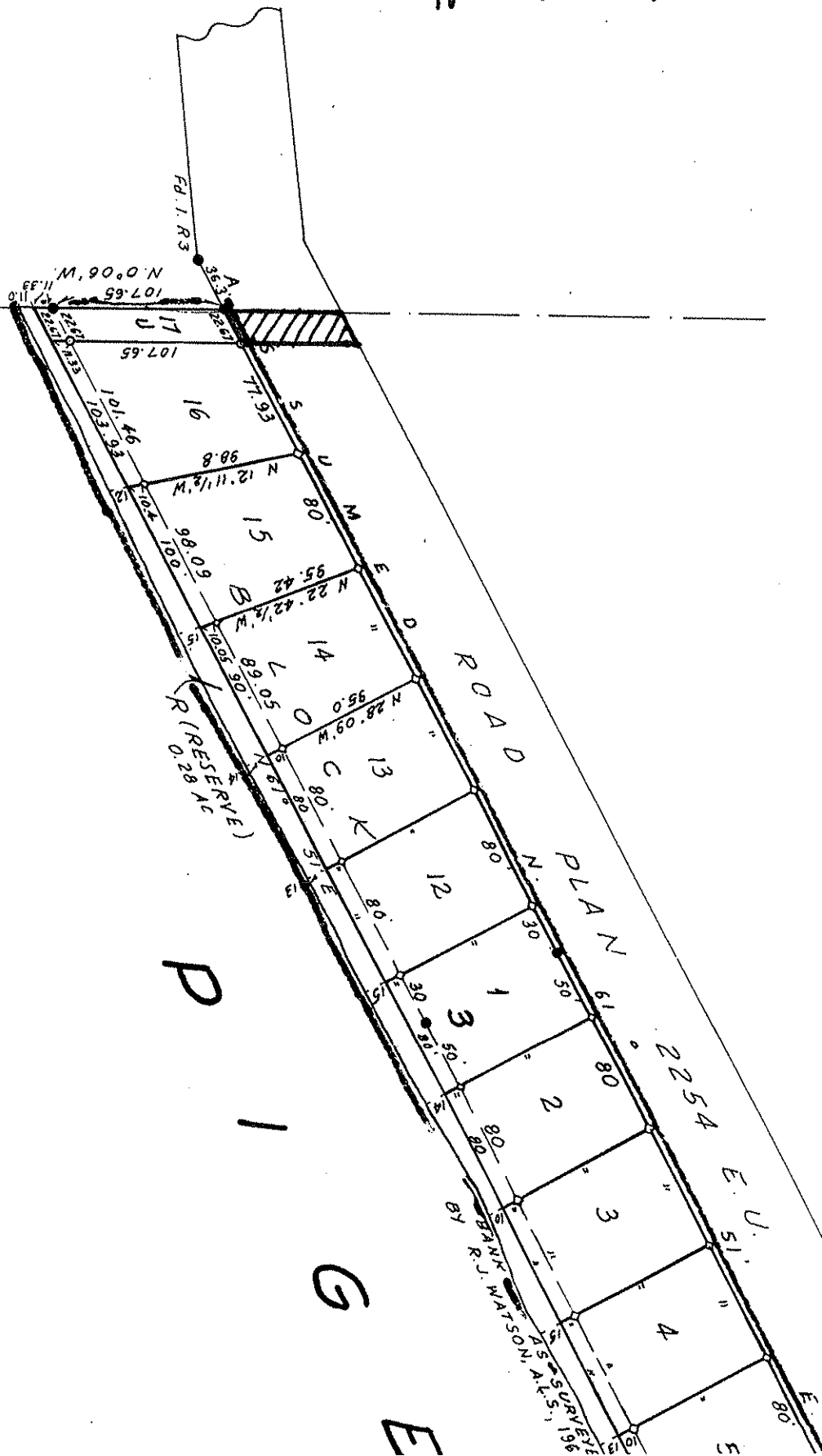
